## **Regional Development Australia Fund**

On March 3, 2011 Malcolm Osborne (Chair) and Carol Mann (EO) travelled to Canberra to attend the RDA National Forum. During the forum the Minister for Regional Australia, Regional Development and Local Government, The Hon Simon Crean MP, announced the establishment of the \$1 billion Regional Development Australia Fund.

The Fund will boost economic and community development in regional Australia and is a new approach to unlocking the potential of Australia's regions by focusing on locally driven solutions to regional needs.

Local Government bodies and incorporated Not-For-Profit organisations are eligible to apply for funding.

Grants of between \$500,000 and \$25 million will be available to support projects. Grants of more than \$5 million must be matched with funds from sources other than the Australian Government. To ensure an immediate and positive impact, projects must be 'investment ready' and all planning, rezoning, environmental and native title approvals should be in place.
