ABOUT THE PROGRAM ERS



The Future Leaders Program Goldfields is an exciting new program that will be run in 2021 for aspiring leaders in the Goldfields region. The program has been designed to invest in the next generation of leaders by providing them with opportunities to learn and develop leadership skills to benefit our local region.

The Future Leaders Program Goldfields will be delivered by Regional Development Australia Goldfields Esperance (RDAGE) in partnership with the Kalgoorlie-Boulder Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KBCCI) and Central Regional TAFE. These program partners will support participants, through training and workshops, to:









*Applicants outside this age range may be accepted, pending discussion with the Program Coordinator



Develop and strengthen an understanding of teams, workplace relationships and individual motivations



Develop and strengthen an understanding of local and regional businesses and their role in driving a local economy



Recognise the importance of strong networks and relationships internally and externally in business and the community



Focus on building individual leadership and strategic skills

Employers will have an opportunity to be involved in the Future Leaders Program Goldfields as mentors, supporting a strong networking and collaborative business community. The objective is to build skills that benefit both the employee and the employer, in turn benefiting the regional business community.

WHAT'S INVOLVED?

The Future Leaders Program Goldfields will run over approximately ten (10) months and will commence in September 2021.

The successful applicants will be required to commit to attending two afternoons/ evenings each month for the duration of the program. On the first Tuesday of each month Central Regional TAFE will host a lecture (commencing at 4:30pm) which will cover the unit requirements of the Certificate IV in Leadership and Management.

On the third Tuesday of each month KBCCI will host an afternoon/evening business workshop. Both sessions will be live streamed when required to encourage attendance and build capacity in the greater Goldfields region.

Participants will also need to commit to additional hours in order to complete the necessary TAFE study, learning and assessment requirements in addition to the above. We estimate 2-4 hours per week.

APPLICATION TYPES

There will be 16 positions available which have been allocated according to the following identifiable market sectors (if you are unsure which category you fall into, please ask!):

CORPORATE

These positions are for larger businesses who have a broad support network and are able to contribute to the financial sustainability of this program.

The participant or their employer will pay the full program cost, being \$2,392*.

LOCAL BUSINESS

These subsidised positions are available to small local businesses (ie approx 20 full time employees) to provide an opportunity for their staff to attend without the financial burden.

RDAGE will subsidise the cost per participant, reducing it to just \$500*.

NOT-FOR-PROFIT

These fully subsidised positions are available to not-for-profit entities to support the leadership and management skills within the Goldfields region.

These positions will be at no cost to the successful applicants, with RDAGE covering the full cost*.

* Cost to cover the TAFE component. There is no fee for the mentoring aspect or business workshops.

PROGRAM PARTNERS

The delivery of the Future Leaders Program Goldfields has been made possible through the collaborative efforts of three agencies that understand the importance of building on the skills, knowledge and competencies in our remote regions and are working together to develop ways to make this happen.







FHOW TO APPLY? EADERS



Interested individuals need to complete an application form outlining why they would like to be involved in the program, how they intend to undertake the study required, their future leadership aspirations as well as what they hope to gain on a personal level. All applications must be accompanied by an endorsement from the applicant's employer (note: employer includes community groups).

Applications close 6 August 2021.



PROGRAM CONDITIONS

- Applicants will receive feedback on their application forms.
- Applicants will be kept informed during each selection round.
- Successful applicants are expected to commit the necessary time required to complete the Certificate IV in Leadership and Management course, attending all the TAFE lectures (4:30pm on first Tuesday of each month), while also ensuring they attend a minimum of 7 of the 9 business workshops (third Tuesday of each month).
- The TAFE lecturer may attend the applicant's place of business to conduct a workplace assessment.
